

Sorting Recyclable Materials

Materials should be clean and free of food waste

- Paper and Card Paper
- Cardboard (boxes broken down flat)
- Plastics (#1 to #7 are accepted)
- Styrofoam (#6 accepted)
- Aseptic Containers (milk, ice cream & juice cartons, fast food, coffee cups, ect...)
- Glass (all colors)
- Metal (all types are accepted)
- Small Electronics (plug in or battery powered)
- Batteries (household, car & rechargeable)
- Lightbulbs (all types are accepted, some types have additional charge)

Other items accepted (additional charges)

- Large Electronic Waste
- Lightbulbs - CFL & Florescent
- Appliances
- Mattresses & Box Springs
- Furniture
- TV Sets & Monitors with CRT Screens

Keep it simple

- no need to tear labels off cans
- no need to rip plastic off tissue boxes

Bag It

Please make sure materials are bagged up and easy to move from your bin to trailer.

Please bag items in clear kitchen sized, larger plastic bags or biodegradable bags. No grocery bags please.

Biodegradable Bags

- BARC sells biodegradable plastic bags
- \$18 for 100 bags

Bring it Together

- Paper and cardboard together
- Plastic, glass & metal together
- Small electronics bagged separately
- Batteries bagged separately
- Light bulbs bagged separately
